
SPOTLIGHT ON THE CEDAR COUNTY TEACHER SALARY ENHANCEMENT FUND

“Thanks to generous donors to help start this fund, we believe our school system can shape our youth for generations to come, through excellent faith-filled teachers.”



Assets by type


